


Thank you for your enthusiasm in helping to spread the word about the survey. Let's keep this excitement going as it will be essential in driving momentum over these next two months!

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Congratulations to the following 4 regions who have 100+ patient respondents and will be receiving a country report:


- United States of America

Currently, there are **1,003 partially-completed surveys**. If respondents use the same browser and have cookies enabled, responses to date will have been saved and they can pick up where they left off and complete the survey.
